### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

***Skiing is an exciting and fulfilling sport, but as with all sports there are safety issues to consider.***

***Participation on training evenings or training camps should be a partnership between the skiers, coaches and parents.***

***For training sessions to be a safe and pleasurable time for all, the following Code of Conduct in addition to the FIS Skiway Code must be adhered to***

#### **Trainee's Must**

- Obey the rules of the slope at all times
- Behave in an appropriate manner and show respect to all slope users
- Follow instructions of their coach and respect their judgement
- Be responsible for their own equipment and respect the equipment of others
- Arrive on time for sessions with their equipment serviced, and ready to train
- Be registered as a member of Gloucester Ski Club for insurance purposes and pay the appropriate coaching fees on the night
- Use the lift system in a safe and appropriate manner and respect others in the queue and await your turn
- Not to leave the slope for any reason without first notifying their coach
- Give way to users below and choose a route that will not endanger or alarm them
- Keep the run out at the bottom of the slope clear at all times. This is not a spectator area or a place to store equipment
- Look up and down the slope before setting off
- Ensure that rubber pole protectors are fitted at all times

***If an athlete does not adhere to the Code of Conduct, the following sanctions will be put into action:***

- 1) VERBAL WARNING BY INDIVIDUALS COACH**
- 2) VERBAL WARNING BY SENIOR COACH**
- 3) ONE WEEK'S SUSPENSION FROM TRAINING**
- 4) FOUR WEEK'S SUSPENSION FROM TRAINING**
- 5) DISCUSSION WITH MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE (Senior Coach in attendance and a representative for the athlete) AS TO WHETHER THE TRAINEE CAN CONTINUE TO ATTEND **GLOUCESTER SKI CLUB****
